

West 40 RESPRO E-Plan Guide for 2007 testing

Plans are due the 2nd, 4th, and 6th year in state or federal school improvement status and every other year henceforth, while the school or district remains in academic status. The obligation to submit an Improvement Plan (IP) to ISBE is only removed if the school or district makes AYP for two consecutive years. Until that time, the school or district remains on the every other year submission cycle.

District and School Improvement Plans due based on 2007 testing and AYP calculation will be for school years 2007/08 and 2008/09.
